Draw

BBNZ cannot guarantee that team requests will be catered for in the draw, but have tried to accommodate where possible. Please be aware, as there are many teams making similar requests not all could be fulfilled.

19 Boys Teams

- 1 round robin - 4 pool of 5
- 1-8 Quarter, semi, finals for 1st/2nd qualifiers in each pool
- 9-16 Quarter, semi, finals for 3rd/4th qualifiers in each pool
- 17-19 Bottom 3 round robin for 5th qualifiers in each pool

17 Girls Teams

- 1 round robin – 3 pools of 4 and 1 pool of 5
- 1-8 Quarter, semi, finals for top 2 qualifiers in each pool
- 9-12 Middle 4 round robin for 3rd place finishers in each pool
- 13-17 Bottom 5 round robin for 4th and 5th qualifiers in each pool
 - 4th Pool D v 5th Pool D – result will be carried over from pool play
 - 4th pool A, 4th pool B and 4th Pool C play 2x games on day 4

Seeding/Pools

Seeding of teams is taken from the 2017 Aon U17 National Championships final team placing. The result from external (non BBNZ) competitions and/or tournaments is not used in the seeding process.

Rules and Regulations

The playing rules shall consist of the rules of FIBA, BBNZ's Internal Regulations, Drug Free Sport New Zealand (DFSNZ) Policies, BBNZ's Match Fixing Policy.

Times

- Warm Up - Minimum of 10 minutes
- Playing Time - 4 x 10 minute stop clock quarters
- Half Time – 5 minutes
- Quarter Time Intervals – 2 minutes
- Extra Periods – 5 minutes
- Extra Period Intervals – 2 minutes



Technical Meeting

The technical meeting is compulsory, we ask that the coach and manager of each team to attend. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, 10th July 7.00pm in the Matairangi Room at the ASB Sports Centre, 72 Kemp Street, Kilbirnie. Please bring your finalised roster to this meeting for eligibility checks. Programmes and Tournament Packs will be available for collection at the technical meeting.

Score Bench Duty

Wellington Basketball will cover first round each day and the semi-finals and finals for the top 4. If you require assistance before the tournament please refer to WBA contacts above.

Scoresheets

Scoresheets will be available outside the control room for teams to check prior to their game. Please do not remove the scoresheets from the table. Teams that require copy of completed scoresheets can request these at the tournament control room.



Volunteers

Volunteers will be wearing black and yellow Wellington Basketball t-shirts/hoodies. Any assistance required, please approach a volunteer.

Uniforms

- Each team must bring two alternate uniforms to the tournament. Teams shall use numbers 0 and 00 and from 1 to 99.
- In the event of a uniform clash Team A is to wear their light coloured uniforms and Team B is to wear their dark coloured uniforms, unless both teams come to a mutual agreement.

Important Details

- Forfeit of Game - \$500 fine.
- Mouthguards are compulsory for all players, The No Mouthguard, No Play Policy is to be firmly enforced. WBA will have a stock of mouthguards to purchase from their office at \$10.00.
- Team Benches – Sitting at the scorebench; Team A **MUST** sit to the left and Team B **MUST** sit to the right. Please ensure all games start correctly with this procedure. Only the rostered players and team management are allowed to sit on the team bench. All supporters must sit in the stands.
- Scorebench - If there is a problem with the scorebench, only the coach may approach on a dead ball and then ask the referee to check the enquiry. Other management may approach the bench during the quarter times and at half time break. They **MUST NOT** approach the bench any other time to check the score sheet or query the scorebench.

Behaviour at National Championships

We have on occasion seen a range of poor behaviour demonstrated by spectators, coaches and players over the past two years. Disappointingly this has occurred largely at the lower age level tournaments. Consequently, in 2018 there will be strict enforcement of the BBNZ Internal Regulations.

Venue Information

Stadium

The ASB Sports Centre, 72 Kemp Street, Kilbirnie, Wellington

Courts will be available 30mins prior to the first round for warm up.

Traffic to the ASB Sports Centre

Allow plenty of time to get to your games.

Canteen

Wishbone café will be operational during normal business times.

Changing Rooms

There are 4 changing rooms available at the stadium.

Toilets and Showers

Toilets and showers are located in the 4 changing rooms.

Video Taping

Please stay clear of spectator seating and access ways when setting up for any videotaping. All videotaping must be done on the mezzanine.

Parking

Free parking is available at the ASB Sports Centre, covered and uncovered.

House Keeping

Evacuation

Assembly points are noted on signage by the emergency exit points. Evacuation points will vary depending on where you are in the arena.

Food and Drink

- No food or hot drinks, high heeled shoes are allowed on the courts.
- Only water and sports drinks are permitted onto the court.

First Aid

- Blood kits are available at Control room and at reception
- ASB Staff will provide First aid assistance when required, go to control desk or reception for assistance.
- Injury reporting – the ASB Sports Centre and Basketball NZ will have injury report forms to fill out.
