

## **2021 U23 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS TOURNAMENT**

### **Host by Basketball Hawkes Bay– August 11<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Draw**

BBNZ cannot guarantee that team requests will be catered for in the draw but have tried to accommodate where possible. Please be aware, as there are many teams making similar requests not all could be fulfilled.

#### **Mens – 15 Teams**

- 1 round robin - 3 pools 4, 1 pool of 3
- Prelim QF's
  - 1<sup>st</sup> in pools automatically qualify for 1-8 QF's
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>'s play a prelim Quarter Final (second chance)
- 1-8 QF / SF / F
  - Winner of prelim QF's advance to the 1-8 QF's
  - Losers of prelim QF's advance to the 9-12 QF's
- 4<sup>th</sup> in each pool play in the 9-15 B3RR.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Pool D has a BYE on the last day.

#### **Seeding/Pools**

Seeding for the 2021 U23 National Champs are based off the 2019 U23 final placings and 2021 entries.

#### **Rules and Regulations**

The playing rules shall consist of the rules of FIBA, BBNZ's Internal Regulations, Drug Free Sport New Zealand (DFSNZ) Policies, BBNZ's Match Fixing Policy and unless specifically changed in these rules.

#### **Technical Meeting & Team Roster**

The technical meeting is compulsory, we ask that the coach and manager of each team to attend. The meeting will be held on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> August via Zoom. The meeting will be recorded and therefore available to listen to post meeting. The zoom link will be emailed to team contacts. Please email your finalised roster to [tournaments@nz.basketball](mailto:tournaments@nz.basketball) prior to this meeting for eligibility checks.

Please note that by providing your roster to BBNZ, the Association has undertaken player eligibility checks to ensure each player listed in your roster is eligible to participate for your Association.

The Association is responsible for the eligibility of its players at all times and will bear the consequences of any infractions of the Regulations governing Eligibility and Age of Players.

#### **Times**

- Warm Up - Minimum of 10 minutes
- Playing Time - 4 x 10 minute stop clock quarters
- Half Time – 5 minutes
- Quarter Time Intervals – 2 minutes
- Extra Periods – 5 minutes
- Extra Period Intervals – 2 minutes

#### **Opening Ceremony**

There will be no opening ceremony for this tournament.

#### **Tournament Information**

All info can be found on the BBNZ website, including draws and programmes.

### **Score Bench Duty**

Your team will be rostered to complete scorebench duty. Please provide four competent score bench personnel for your duty. Every effort will be made to assist teams when able. As Host we will cover the opening and closing games each day plus the semi-finals and finals.

In addition to this, the tournament will be using the GLORY LEAGUE Scoring app to score games. If your team is not familiar with the app please have a look at the following resources. We suggest a minimum of 4 bench personnel when covering a scorebench duty.

### **Uniforms**

- Each team must bring two alternate uniforms to the tournament. Teams shall use numbers 0 and 00 and from 1 to 99.
- In the event of a uniform clash Team A is to wear their light coloured uniforms and Team B is to wear their dark coloured uniforms, unless both teams come to a mutual agreement.

### **Important Details**

- Forfeit of Game - \$500 fine.
- Team Benches – Sitting at the scorebench; Team A **MUST** sit to the left and Team B **MUST** sit to the right. Please ensure all games start correctly with this procedure. Only the rostered players and team management are allowed to sit on the team bench. All supporters must sit in the stands.
- Scorebench - If there is a problem with the scorebench, only the coach may approach on a dead ball and then ask the referee to check the enquiry. Other management may approach the bench during the quarter times and at half time break. They **MUST NOT** approach the bench any other time to check the score sheet or query the scorebench.

### **Behaviour at National Championships**

We have on occasion seen a range of poor behaviour demonstrated by spectators, coaches and players over the past two years. Disappointingly this has occurred largely at the lower age level tournaments. Consequently, in 2017 BBNZ introduced stricter enforcement of their regulations.

Please ensure that all team management, players and attending spectators are advised and provided the BBNZ Code of Conduct and Harassment. ### **Door Charge**

### **Tournament Control Room**

The tournament control room will be in the level one meeting room, any queries to BBNZ or the Tournament Director can be made here.

The floor controller can be found at the baseline of court 1 & 2.

### **Canteen**

There is a Subway on site (open 7:30am – 8:30pm Wed through Friday and 9am-7pm Saturday) and food trucks on site at various times during the tournament.

### **Changing Rooms**

There are changing rooms available at the arena- please note these changing rooms are part of the public area which includes an onsite gym so please respect other users throughout.

### **Toilets and Showers**

Toilets and showers are located in the changing rooms.

### **Video Taping**

Please stay clear of spectator seating and access ways when setting up for any video taping. Please only record from the level one area, no on court filming.

### **Rubbish**

Please be considerate and ensure your team removes any rubbish from the bench at the end of your game. Please do not leave rubbish in the changing rooms and leave in a tidy state for other teams.

### **Parking**

Free parking is available at Pettigrew Arena.

### **Evacuation**

Assembly points are noted on signage by the emergency exit points. Evacuation points will vary depending on where you are in the arena.

### **First Aid**

- Injury reporting – the Host Association to document all injuries in conjunction with the stadium.
- Blood kits are available at the floor controller's desk.
- Ice and a basic first aid kit are available in at the floor controllers desk
- All Hawkes Bay floor controllers and staff are first aid trained and will be the first point of call to any injuries
- Physio – to be confirmed – onsite physio
