Purpose of the Roles

The Head Coach of their respective team is charged with leading and implementing a training and performance programme for the 2023 U17 3x3 Teams, in preparation for the 2023 FIBA 3x3 Asia Cup. They will lead and contribute to an athlete development pathway that inspires and is manageable and sustainable.

Term of appointment

The term of appointment for both teams is from 22 December 2022 through to 1 November 2023. Based on performances and management of the U17 programme, there is an opportunity for the coach to be re-appointed to the 2024 FIBA 3x3 U18 World Cup campaign.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Head Coaches will be responsible for:

- The preparation, development and implementation of a program for the team in line with Basketball New Zealand (BBNZ) preferred style of play.
- Establishment and management of the objectives of the program in consultation with the BBNZ High Performance 3x3 Director and 3x3 Senior National Team Coaches.
- Selection of the athletes for the program in line with BBNZ's selection policy and FIBA player eligibility guidelines.
- Develop and prepare competition and training schedules for the program through effective prioritisation around athlete development and performance environments.
- Identify appropriate sports science and performance requirements to ensure that the program continues to be world's best.
- Maintain communication with other areas of the BBNZ High Performance program in particular with the high performance department and key 3x3 stakeholders.
- Prepare and present reports on the program as required.
- Liaise, where appropriate, with the club coaches and other officials of the teams of the athletes selected for the program.
- Representing the team with media and sponsorship requests when required.
- Responsive to e-mails and phone calls
- Ensure that social media around the team is conducted in the most professional manner.

Communication and working relationship

The Head Coaches will have proven and effective leadership and communication skills, including a capacity to liaise with a wide range of people. In general, they will be directly responsible to report team performance outcomes to the High Performance 3x3 Director. The Head Coaches

will collaborate with the 3x3 Senior National Team Coaches and other High Performance staff regarding the team's approved program.

Key performance indicators

- Leadership and communication with other stakeholders involved with the 2023 FIBA 3x3 Asia Cup campaign.
- Communication and monitoring with coaches and identified athletes.
- Apply a proactive approach to recruitment of athletes who meet the selection criteria.
- Athletes to demonstrate progression/adaptation to the demands of international basketball (competition factors, travel, food, cultural differences) over the course of the campaign.
- Successful delivery of the FIBA 3x3 U17 Asia Cup campaign.
- Top three placing at the 2023 FIBA 3x3 U17 Asia Cup, qualifying for the 2024 FIBA 3x3 U18 World Cup.

Program Outline

Coaches will be required to lead the delivery of all performance elements at regional and national selection camps, in line with Basketball New Zealand's style of play philosophy. There is also a requirement to attend other events for talent identification purposes, i.e., national age group tournaments and 3x3 events.

- 3x3 Pro Tour – Summer 2022-2023
- 3x3 Secondary School Nationals – March 30 - April 2
- National Camps – TBC
- FIBA 3x3 U17 Asia Cup – TBC

Based on performances and management of the U17 programme, there is an opportunity for the coach to be re-appointed to the 2024 FIBA 3x3 U18 World Cup campaign.
