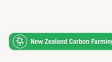

Seeding/ Pools

Seeding of teams is taken from the final team placing of the 2021 Secondary School 3x3 Tournament. Results from external (non BBNZ) competitions and/or tournaments are not used in the seeding process. If there is more than one team that did not compete at the 3x3 Champs in the previous year BBNZ will seed the teams at their discretion.

Referees

As previously mentioned, all teams will be rostered for refereeing duties either before or after they play. For those that are on the second round of each day, you will be allocated to games on the FIRST round.

Referees should introduce themselves to the Technical Commissioner – Devina Banks – who will be in the referee room, upon arrival at the stadium.

Should your team referee not have a “referee shirt” please ensure they have either a grey top, or a couple of options available to ensure they do not clash with any team colours.

Score Bench

Your team will be rostered to do score bench duty. Please provide three competent score bench personnel for your duty. Every effort will be made to assist teams when able. As Hosts we do not have the capabilities to provide for every game. Please be respectful of these requests. A roster will be sent to all teams prior to the start of the tournament.

Score Sheets

Please ensure that all players are listed on the team roster as no further changes will be allowed to players named after the technical meeting. All further score sheets will be completed for your team and can be located at tournament control room. Please inform the tournament organisers if player numbers are to be changed during the tournament. *Once a team’s first game commences, only those players listed on the scoresheet for the first game may participate in the remainder of that Tournament as players. [BBNZ Internal Regulations F1.5].*

Team Roster

Please ensure that all your players are registered on Play.Fiba3x3 and are eligible to compete in the tournament and that all players comply with BBNZ and SSNZ rules and regulations. Reminder that a maximum of 5 players only can participate in the tournament.

Important Details

- Forfeit of Game – \$100 fine.
- Team Benches – Sitting at the score bench; Team A MUST sit to the left (light uniforms) and Team B MUST sit to the right (dark uniforms). Please ensure all games start correctly with this procedure. Only the rostered players are allowed to sit on the team bench. All supporters and coach/manager must sit in the stands.
- The 3x3 Champs will use BBNZ Internal Regulations, Official FIBA 3X3 Basketball Rules of the Game with outlined amendment made by Basketball New Zealand and SSNZ Regulations and Eligibility. Please use the BBNZ web link - to obtain the rules of the game.
- Classification of Teams – using Official FIBA 3X3 Basketball Rules.

Team Benches

Each team will have two chairs for substitutions.

Playing Uniform

Each team must bring two alternate uniforms to the tournament. Uniform numbers must be 0 and 00 and 1 to 99.

- **COMPRESSION** shirts and leggings can be worn, but each team member wearing these must have the same colour garments.

Times

- **Warm Up** – 5 minutes
- **Playing Time** – 10min Running Clock
- **Overtime** – First team to score 2 points.

First Aid

- Injury reporting – the Host Association to document all injuries in conjunction with BBNZ and the Arena. If any players suffer an injury, please find a tournament official for the form.
- Blood kits are available at the tournament control room.
- A basic first aid kit is available from the tournament office and at the venue reception.
- Ice can be found in the tournament office. Ice is only to be used for on court injuries.

Health and Safety

Physio

Come and see the Physio Rehab Group physios court side or make an individual appointment at the on-site clinic at Pulman Park by phoning 09 2748056.

No charge for injury assessment and treatment **court side**

ACC forms, Doctor & X-ray referrals can be arranged via the physiotherapists.

No charge for strapping (if you supply your own tape).

You can choose to purchased strapping tape from the on-site Physio's at wholesale rates:

Rigid tape – \$10 a roll

EAB – \$10- \$15 a roll

K tape – \$16 a roll

OR pay \$5 per joint for strapping.

Video Taping

No on court videotaping allowed, must be done from the mezzanine upstairs. No livestreaming through your own channels is permitted.

Livestreaming and Broadcasting

Selected senior games on the show court are to be streamed on Whakaata Maori YouTube throughout the day on Friday and Saturday. We are aiming for the Senior Grand Finals to be live on Whakaata Maori TV on Saturday afternoon.

Due to the age of participants, we are not broadcasting the Junior round robin, quarter finals, or semifinals. However, the Grand Finals of the 4 junior grades will be broadcast on the Whakaata Maori YouTube channel.

Parking

Parking will be available at Pulman Arena.

Merchandise

- Pre-ordered T-shirts can be collected from the merchandise stand in the foyer at the Arena throughout the tournament.
- You will also be able to order at the event, and then pick up the next day.

Activation Zone

An outdoor activation zone (weather depending) will be onsite at Pulman Park for teams and spectators to enjoy! You can expect to see NBL/Tauihi teams, Mai FM, YouthTown, Table Tennis, a sausage sizzle plus more throughout the four days!

Rubbish

Please be considerate and ensure your team removes any rubbish from the bench at the end of your game. Changing rooms – please do not leave rubbish in the changing rooms and please leave in a tidy state for other teams.

Canteen

Arena Café is situated in the foyer area. Open 9am–5pm daily. Only food purchased at the Café may be brought into the arena.

Drug, Smoke and Alcohol-Free Tournament

This is a drug, smoke, and alcohol-free tournament. Please respect this regulation, you will be evicted from the premises if you are found with or are believed to be on any of these substances (drug or alcohol).

Arena Information

- **Changing Rooms** – Located on the left of the walkway prior to entering the court area. Open for all teams.
- **Toilets and Showers** – Located on the left of the walkway prior to entering the court area.
- **Canteen** – Located on the right side of the main entry to the Basketball Arena.
- **NO food or drink is permitted inside the Pulman Arena playing court area.** (Except for water bottles for teams which may only be utilized on the carpeted areas between courts)
- **NO water bottles are to be taken onto the playing wooden court area.** Water bottles to stay on carpeted area designated for teams off court. No glass bottles are permitted.
- **NO chewing gum is permitted anywhere inside the Pulman Arena building.**
- **Only NON-MARKING court shoes are to be worn on the court.** Strictly **NO** street shoes/heels/work boots are to be worn onto the playing area. Players to change into court shoes once they have arrived at the Arena.
- **NO running or uncontrolled behaviour in the Mezzanine or non-court areas in the building** – Children under the age of 12 must always be supervised.
- **NO ALCOHOL** is to be brought onto the premises.
- The Arena and/or Arena staff **are not** responsible for any lost or stolen articles. Please see Control Room
- All equipment is to be used in the correct manner and no alteration or amendment to the facilities are allowed without authorization.
- Good sportsmanship & behaviour is expected. The Arena Staff reserves the right to remove anyone who in their opinion is behaving in an unacceptable manner.
- **NO** playing with sports gear (including sports balls) in the foyer or mezzanine areas.
- **Only players assigned coaches and manager are allowed on the court areas.** Teams will be called onto the courts 15 to 30mins prior to their game. All other persons including parents will be asked to sit in seating areas upstairs.
