VENUE AND GAME INFORMATION

- No door charge
- Tournament office Location: On right heading into entry to 6 Court Stadium
- Stadiums will be open <u>30 minutes</u> prior to the first round.
- Placement of notice board with Results outside tournament office in the venue.
- Clean Up your benches after games- quick transitions, clean before you leave
- Video Taping- no on court taping, only from the stands out of the way of spectators.
- Evacuation Plan- Leave the building immediately via the closest exit. please follow instructions from the venue staff. An evacuation plan is available in the H&S notes.

DRAW STRUCTURE

Boys A Grade – 12 Teams

1 round robin, 2 pools of 6 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th qualifiers in each pool play 1-8 QF, SF, F 5th & 6th qualifiers in each pool to play 9-12 SF-F

Boys B Grade - 12 Teams

1 round robin, 2 pools of 6 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th qualifiers in each pool play 1-8 QF, SF, F 5th & 6th qualifiers in each pool to play 9-12 SF-F

Boys C Grade – 9 Teams

1 round robin, 1 pool of 4, 1 pool of 5 1st from each pool qualify for 1-4 SF-F 2nd & 3rd play in the PLSFs – winners qualify for 1-4 SF-F, losers play for 5th & 6th 4th Pool A & B, and 5th Pool B play B3RR

Game Points: 2 points for win, 1 point for a loss or default, 0 for a forfeit

- 2 way tie head to head result between the two teams
- 3 or more way tie head to head result between the teams tied, if they have the same win/loss then points difference will be used (ONLY IN GAMES BETWEEN THE TIED TEAMS)

Girls A Grade – 8 Teams

1 round robin, 2 pools of 4 All teams play in 1-8 QF, SF, F

Girls B Grade – 8 Teams

1 round robin, 2 pools of 4 All teams play in 1-8 QF, SF, F



COMPETITION INFORMATION

TIMES

- Warm Up Minimum of 10 minutes
- Playing Time 4 x 8-minute stop clock quarters
- Half Time 5 minutes
- Quarter Time Intervals 2 minutes
- Extra Periods 5 minutes
- Extra Period Intervals 2 minutes

SITTING ON THE SCOREBENCH

- Team A MUST sit to the Left of the score bench
- Team B MUST sit to the Right of the score bench

TEAM BENCHES

- No more than 12 players entitled to play
- A maximum of 3 team management members to sit on each team bench



COMPETITION INFORMATION

SCORE SHEETS AND BALLS

- Procedure for game balls: Referees will store and bring to games. Referees will collect the game balls the end of the games
- All games are scored on iPads, on Glory League.
- Score Duty Roster- teams please be-aware of your bench duties as rostered on in the draw. These assigned games will be directly after your game you have just played.
- On days Three and Four of the tournament, it is often the loser of the previous match who is assigned to bench duty, so be prepared.

UNIFORM, TEAM LISTS AND NUMBERS

- Check every team list carefully on iPads before each game.
- Player numbers can change from game to game.

REFEREE INFORMATION

UNIFORMS

- In the event of a colour clash- Team A will wear a light strip. However we ask that teams
 work together to ensure we do not have to resort to this rule. A clash is only similar
 colours not two dark or light shades. Bibs are available from the venue controllers table at
 both venues if needed
- Undergarments: All compression garments are allowed but <u>all players</u> on the team must wear the <u>same color compression</u>. Only compression garments are permitted, not t-shirts etc.

Special Rules Applying to U14's

- Boys will use the size 6 ball.
- Girls will use the size 5 ball
- The use of zone defence is banned. If a coach suspects their opponent is playing a zone defence, please approach the VC at your venue and ask for a Zone Buster



REFEREE INFORMATION

Team management roles

- The Head Coach is the only team manager who can speak to the referee. In doing so this is to ask a
 question in a dead ball situation. They must accept the answer and move on.
- Team management can approach the score table in a dead ball situation.

Game Protests

- Once the scoresheet is signed (iPad score submitted) by the referees, then the final noted game score stands.
- There are NO game protests- Any complaints can be made directly or forwarded via the host to the Judicial Officer: Sasha Nicholson

Referee Roster

 Please check the score bench and refs roster to make sure all games are covered by who they should be covered by, and that the refs roster for day 2 onwards will be done by Peter Marshall on-site

MOUTHGUARDS ARE COMPULSORY

- Team management to ensure all players are wearing a mouth guard
- Mouth Guards are available for purchase at each venue



BEHAVIOUR

- Coach, Player and Supporter behaviour, as per the BBNZ code of conduct.
- Poor behaviour will not be tolerated
- Please respect all Referees, Staff, Volunteers and participating teams, players and management.
- Each person has an onus as a representative of the sport of basketball to behave appropriately
