VENUE AND GAME INFO



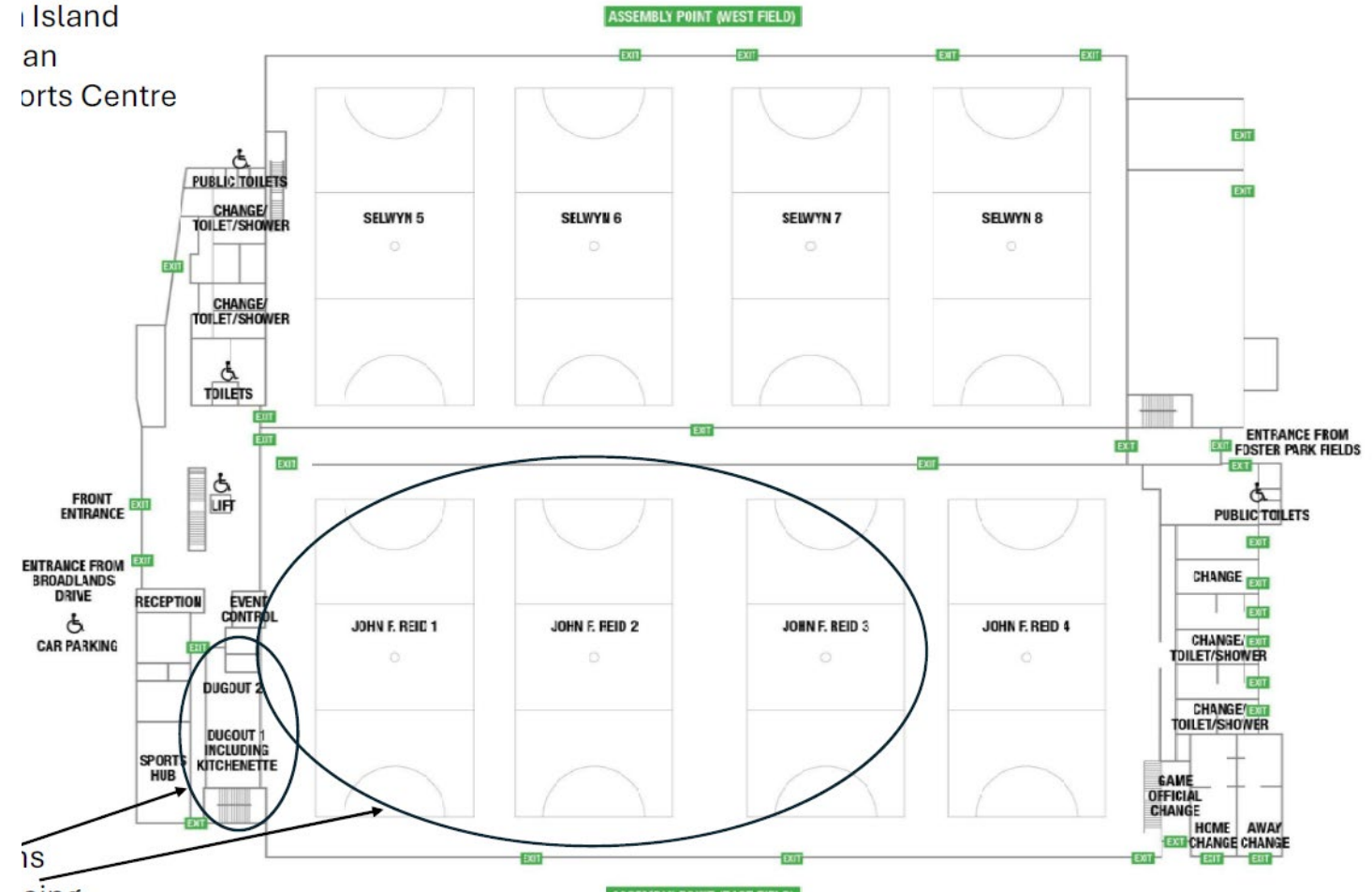
Selwyn Sports Centre

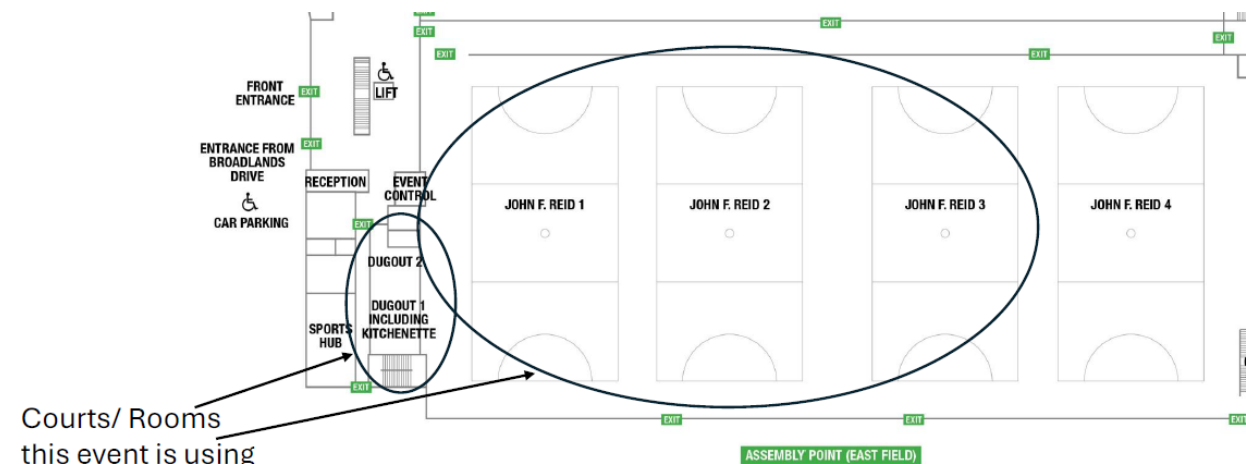
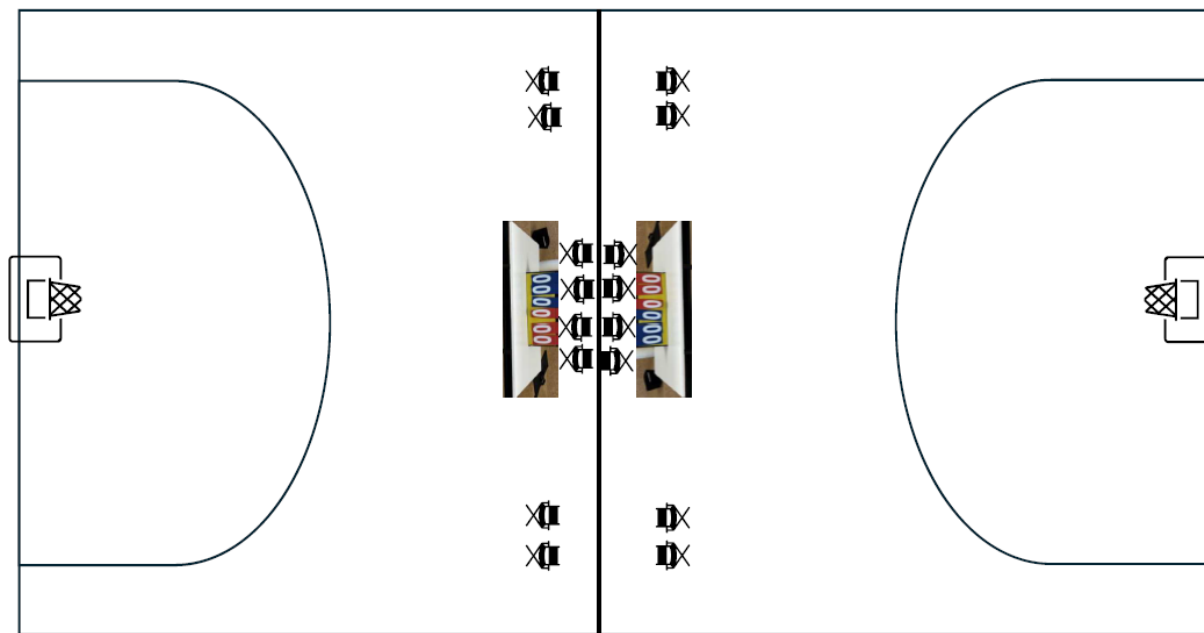

GAME CLOCKS

- 1 x score clock used to display the time for all courts
- These will be visible for all players and referees on all courts

• SCORE BENCH

- Flip charts and Ipads for scoring on all score benches

COMPETITION INFO



The tournament will use BBNZ Internal Regulations, FIBA Rules, Drug Free Sport New Zealand Policies and BBNZ's Match Fixing Policy.

• CLASSIFICATION OF TEAMS

• FIBA Rules as at 18 November 2021 will be used

• GAME POINTS

• 2 points for a win

• 1 point for loss/default (fewer than 2 players on the playing court ready to play.)

• 0 for forfeit of Game & \$100 fine (21-0 scoreline)

• CLASSIFICATIONS

• 2-way tie – win – loss record between the teams tied

• If teams that have reached the same stage of the competition are tied, the steps to break the tie shall be applied in the following order:

• Most wins (or win ratio in case of unequal number of games in inter-pool comparison).

• Head-to-head comparison (only taking win/loss into account and applies within a pool only).

• Most points scored in average (without considering winning scores of forfeits).

• If teams are still tied after those 3 steps, the team(s) with the highest seeding win(s) the tie-break

COMPETITION INFO



- **TIMES**

- Warm up – 5mins

- Playing Time – 10mins Running Clock

- Overtime – First Team to score 2 points

- **IN THE EVENT OF A UNIFORM CLASH**

- Team A is to wear their light-colored uniforms

- Team B is to wear their dark-colored uniforms

- Check with teams before hand if you can!

COMPETITION INFO

- **SCORESHEETS, BALLS & MORE**

- Procedure for game balls – Referees will bring to games.

- **Procedure for scoresheets** – Scoresheets can be available on request. Email tori@nz.basketball to process this request.

- **Scorebench duty roster** – teams be aware of your duties!

- 3 people are needed for scorebench duty
- Score flip-chart

- **MOUTHGUARDS**

- as per the BBNZ policy these should be worn at all times. We will be working with coaches and management on this and will only at a last resort, sub players out (which will not be occurring at the end of the game)

- **UNIFORMS**

- Each team must bring two alternate uniforms to the tournament. Uniform numbers must be 0 and 00 and 1 to 99.
- COMPRESSION shirts and leggings can be worn, but each team member wearing these must have the same colour garments.

- **BEHAVIOUR**

- Coach, Player and Supporter behaviour. As per the BBNZ Code of Conduct, poor behaviour will not be tolerated. A reminder that we all have an onus to present the best possible image of our sport.

REFEREE INFORMATION



• **GAME PROTESTS**

Once the electronic scoresheet is signed by the referees, then the final noted game score stands. There are no game protests, please be aware of the rules above when you have a score or bench concern.

• **COMPLAINTS OFFICER**

• Garratt Williamson is the complaints officer. Basically, anyone can now lay a complaint about poor behaviour and this will be considered by the Complaints Officer based on completing the form and following the process outlined in the BBNZ Rules and Regulations.
