GAME CLOCKS

- 1 x score clock used to display the time for all courts
- These will be visible for all players and referees on all courts

SCORE BENCH

- Flip charts and Ipads for scoring on all score benches
- Scorekeeper guides will be provided on score benches
- Ipads are not to be removed from the scorebench table after games.

COMPETITION INFO



The tournament will use BBNZ Internal Regulations, FIBA 3x3 Rules, Drug Free Sport New Zealand Policies and BBNZ's Match Fixing Policy.

- **CLASSIFICATION OF TEAMS**

- FIBA 3x3 Rules as at 5th December 2024 will be used.

- **GAME POINTS**

- 2 points for a win
- 1 point for loss/default (fewer than 2 players on the playing court ready to play.)
- 0 for forfeit of Game & \$100 fine (W-0 scoreline)

CLASSIFICATIONS

- 2-way tie – win – loss record between the teams tied
- If teams that have reached the same stage of the competition are tied, the steps to break the tie shall be applied in the following order:

Most wins (or win ratio in case of unequal number of games in inter-pool comparison).

Head-to-head comparison (only taking win/loss into account and applies within a pool only).

Most points scored in average (without considering winning scores of forfeits).

If teams are still tied after those 3 steps, the team(s) with the highest seeding win(s) the tie-break

- **TIMES**
- Warm up – 10mins, players to get iPads logged in.
- Playing Time – 10mins Running Clock
- Overtime – First Team to score 2 points
- **IN THE EVENT OF A UNIFORM CLASH**
- - Team A is to wear their light-colored uniforms
- - Team B is to wear their dark-colored uniforms
- - Check with teams before hand if you can!

MOUTHGUARDS

UNIFORMS
