
- Venue address – EA Networks Centre, Ashburton – 20 River Terrace, Ashburton

GAME CLOCKS

- 1 x score clock used to display the time for all courts
- These will be visible for all players and referees on all courts

SCORE BENCH

- Flip charts and Ipads for scoring on all score benches
- Scorekeeper guides will be provided on score benches
- iPads are not to be removed from the scorebench table after games

COMPETITION INFO



The tournament will use BBNZ Internal Regulations, FIBA Rules, Drug Free Sport New Zealand Policies and BBNZ's Match Fixing Policy.

CLASSIFICATION OF TEAMS

- FIBA Rules as at 18 November 2021 will be use

GAME POINTS

- 2 points for a win
- 1 point for loss/default (fewer than 2 players on the playing court ready to play.)
- 0 for forfeit of Game & \$100 fine (21-0 scoreline)

CLASSIFICATIONS

- 2-way tie – win – loss record between the teams tied
- If teams that have reached the same stage of the competition are tied, the steps to break the tie shall be applied in the following order:
 - Most wins (or win ratio in case of unequal number of games in inter-pool comparison).
 - Head-to-head comparison (only taking win/loss into account and applies within a pool only).
 - Most points scored in average (without considering winning scores of forfeits).
- If teams are still tied after those 3 steps, the team(s) with the highest seeding win(s) the tie-break

COMPETITION INFO



TIMES

- Warm up – 10mins, players to get iPads logged in.
- Playing Time – 10mins Running Clock
- Overtime – First Team to score 2 points

• IN THE EVENT OF A UNIFORM CLASH

- - Team A is to wear their light-colored uniforms
- - Team B is to wear their dark-colored uniforms
- - Check with teams before hand if you can!

- **SCORESHEETS, BALLS & MORE**
- Procedure for game balls – Referees will bring to games.

MOUTHGUARDS

- as per the BBNZ policy these should be worn at all times. We will be working with coaches and management on this
- and will only at a last resort, sub players out (which will not be occurring at the end of the game)

UNIFORMS

- Each team must bring two alternate uniforms to the tournament. Uniform numbers must be 0 and 00 and 1 to 99.
- COMPRESSION shirts and leggings can be worn, but each team member wearing these must have the same colour garments.

BEHAVIOUR

- Coach, Player and Supporter behaviour. As per the BBNZ Code of Conduct, poor behaviour will not be tolerated.
- A reminder that we all have an onus to present the best possible image of our sport.

GAME PROTESTS

- Once the games are finalised and the iPads are signed by the referees, then the final noted game score stands.
- There are no game protests

COACHES



- **NO coaching allowed during games.**
- Coaches must be away from the game bench
