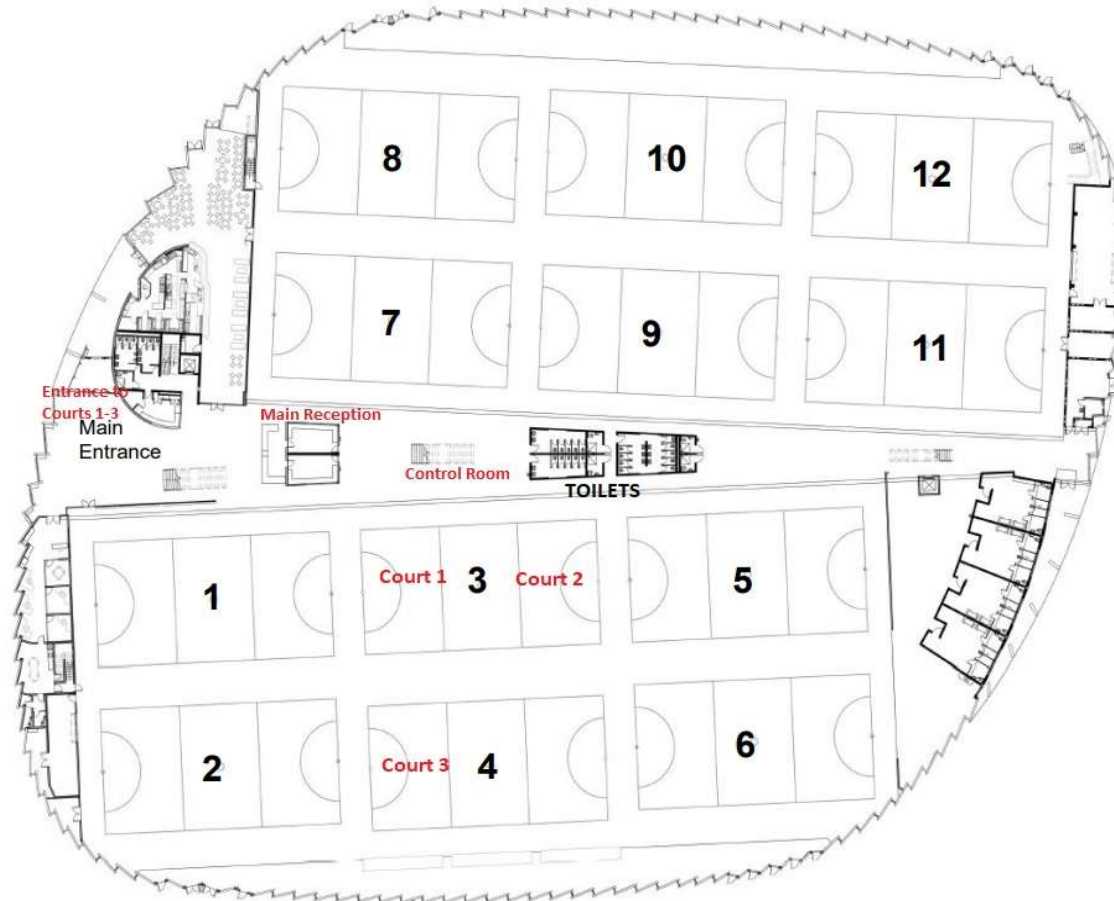


Ākau Tangi Sports Centre

- **Venue entrances & door charge** - No door charge. There is plenty of parking for free of charge
- **Tournament office location** – Near Court 1 (Normal Venue Court 3)
- **Placement of noticeboard for tournament info** – By BBNZ Tournament Office
- **Changing rooms and toilets** – 4x Changing rooms at the back of venue behind court 5 & 6. Plenty of Toilets around the venue.
- **Video Taping** – in the stands away from impeding spectators, no on court video taping – NO LIVESTREAMING
- **Clean up your benches** – quick transitions, clean before you leave
- **Evacuation plan** – Follow venue staff instructions
- **Gathering Points** – Outside main entrance

GAME CLOCKS & SCOREBENCH

- TV will show the score and game clock on each court
- Computer screens will show shot clocks on each court
- These will be visible for all players and referees on all courts
- 30 second timeout during regular time, 1x per team. If not used in regular time, the timeout can be used in overtime. If it has been used in regular time, then the team has no overtime timeouts.
- Timeout can be called during regular time out opportunities – i.e Dead Ball Situations

MEDICAL

The tournament will use BBNZ Internal Regulations, FIBA 3x3 Rules, Drug Free Sport New Zealand Policies and BBNZ's Match Fixing Policy.

- **CLASSIFICATION OF TEAMS**

- FIBA 3x3 Rules as at 1st January 2026 will be used.

- **GAME POINTS**

- 2 points for a win
- 1 point for loss/default (fewer than 2 players on the playing court ready to play.)
- 0 for forfeit of Game & \$100 fine (W-0 scoreline)

- **CLASSIFICATIONS**

- 2-way tie – win – loss record between the teams tied
- If teams that have reached the same stage of the competition are tied, the steps to break the tie shall be applied in the following order:

Most wins (or win ratio in case of unequal number of games in inter-pool comparison).

Head-to-head comparison (only taking win/loss into account and applies within a pool only).

Most points scored in average (without considering winning scores of forfeits).

If teams are still tied after those 3 steps, the team(s) with the highest seeding win(s) the tie-break



NO MOUTHGUARD, NO PLAY

- The No mouthguard No Play Policy is to be firmly enforced, as per regulations
- It is compulsory for all players participating in all age grade (Under 20's and below) to wear mouthguards
- The managers and coaches have a duty of care to ensure that their players are adhering to this mouthguard policy



COMPETITIONS INFO



- **TIMES**

- 20 min blocks
- Playing Time – 10 minutes stop clock or first to 21 points, 30 second timeout.
- No Overtime timeout!
- 10 min change over
- Warm Up
- Extra Periods – first team to score 2 points

- **IN THE EVENT OF A UNIFORM CLASH**

- Team A is to wear their light-colored uniforms
- Team B is to wear their dark-colored uniforms
- Check with teams before hand if you can!

- **TEAM BENCHES**

- 1 sub only, **no coaches or team management to be by team benches**



SCORESHEETS, BALLS & MORE

- Procedure for game balls – Referees will bring to games and collect after the games.
- Procedure for scoresheets – Scoresheets can be available on request. Email jay@nz.basketball to process this request.

MOUTHGUARDS

- as per the BBNZ policy these should be worn at all times. We will be working with coaches and management on this and will only at a last resort, sub players out (which will not be occurring at the end of the game)

UNIFORMS

- Each team must bring two alternate uniforms to the tournament. Uniform numbers must be 0 and 00 and 1 to 99.
- **COMPRESSION** shirts and leggings can be worn, but each team member wearing these must have the same colour garments.

BEHAVIOUR

- Coach, Player and Supporter behaviour. As per the BBNZ Code of Conduct, poor behaviour will not be tolerated.
- A reminder that we all have an onus to present the best possible image of our sport.



GAME PROTESTS

- Once the game on Eventmaker has been finalised, then the final noted game score stands. There are no game protests. If you believe the score is wrong, please have your players alert the referees so they can stop the clock and discuss it, or go get the Floor Controllers or TC so they can sort it out.

JUDICIAL

- Jay Macdonald is the judicial officer. Basically, anyone can now lay a complaint about poor behaviour and this will be considered by the Judicial Officer based on following the process outlined in the BBNZ Rules and Regulations.

EJECTIONS

- Game disqualification is only possible through a player receiving two unsportsmanlike fouls. A player can receive more than two technical fouls and not be game disqualified.



- **NO coaching allowed during games.**
 - Coaches must be in the stands away from the game
- Dress in school branded gear if possible
- Dress appropriately and to a high standard.
 - This does not mean you have to wear a suit or dress shoes



LIVE STREAMING

- All 3 Courts will be livestreamed across both days
- All games will be livestreamed
- This event will be available on Māori + YouTube channel.
 - Grand Finals will be on Whakaata Maori Linear TV as well

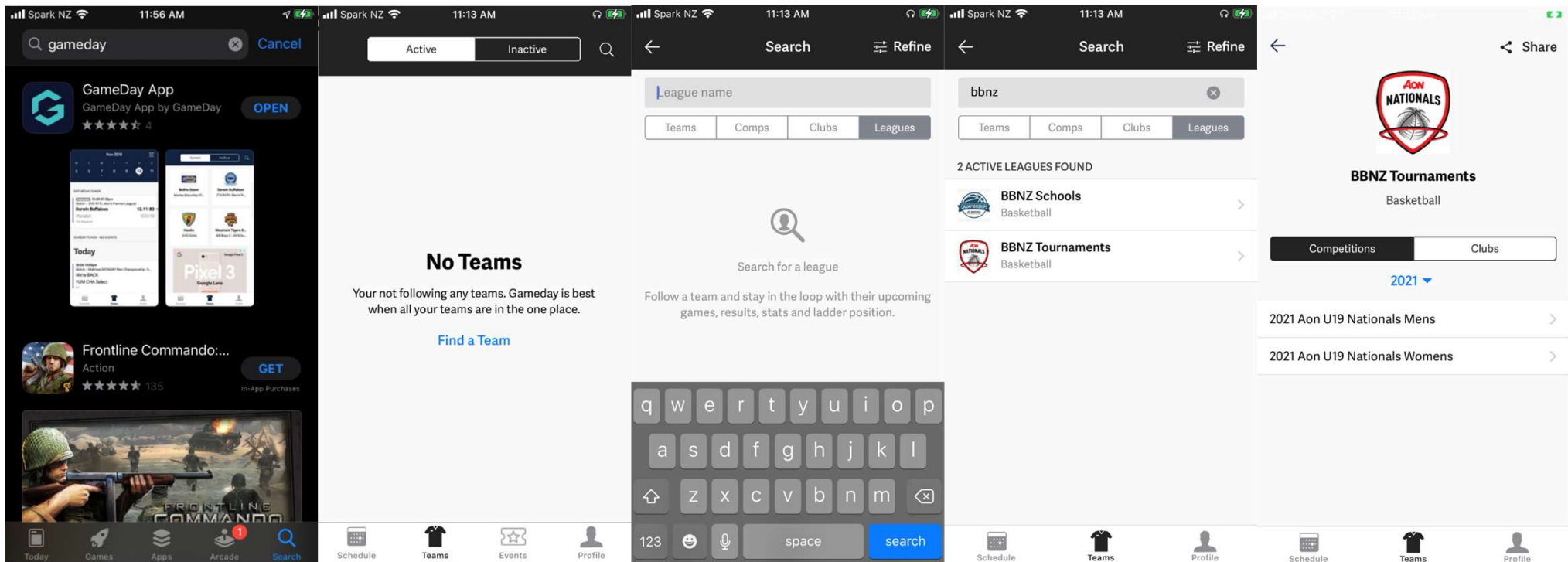
